SHINDAIWA PB270 POWER BROOM

Starting

(Cold Engine)

1. Set the throttle lever to "fast idle" by performing the following:

*Squeeze and hold the throttle lever toward the handle grip.

*Depress and hold the throttle lock button on the throttle body.

*While holding the throttle lock button, release the throttle lever.

2. Slide the ignition switch to the "I" or "ON" position.

3. Prime the engine by repeatedly depressing the carburetor primer bulb until fuel can be seen flowing through the transparent overflow return tube.

4. Choke the engine by moving the choke lever up towards the spark plug (choke is closed).

(Warm engine)

1. Set the throttle lever to "fast idle" as in Step 1 (above).

2. Slide the ignition switch to the "ON" or "I" position.

3. Make sure the choke lever is in the down position (choke is open).

Cranking the Engine

1. While holding the crank shaft tube firmly with your left hand, use your right hand to pull the starter handle slowly upward until you feel the starter engage.

2. Start the PowerBroom by pulling the starter handle rapidly.

3. Open the choke by moving the choke lever down (toward the fuel tank) when the engine starts or fires.

4. If the engine did not continue to run, repeat the cranking procedure as previously described.

5. When the engine starts, clear excess fuel from the combustion area by revving the engine several times with the throttle lever.

6. Operating the throttle will automatically disengage the fast idle setting.

7. If the engine does not start, repeat the procedure for a hot or cold engine. If the engine still fails to start, follow the procedure for starting a flooded engine.

Stopping the Engine

1. Cool the engine by allowing it to idle for two or three minutes.

2. Slide the ignition switch to the "O" or "Off" position.

WARNINGS!

1. MAINTAIN A SHALLOW ANGLE TO THE WORK SURFACE!

2. THE SWEEPER BELTS MAY ROTATE WHEN THE POWERBROOM IS STARTED!

3. YOU MUST ALWAYS GUARD AGAINST THROWN DEBRIS!

4. NEVER OPERATE THE POWERBROOM IF ANY PROTECTIVE DEVICES ARE MISSING OR DAMAGED!

5. NEVER OPERATE THE ENGINE AT HIGH RPM'S WITHOUT A LOAD!

6. AVOID LOW RPM OPERATION!

7. ALWAYS HOLD THE MACHINE FIRMLY WITH BOTH HANDS AND MAINTAIN CONTROL AT ALL TIMES!

8. ALWAYS WEAR EYE PROTECTION TO SHIELD AGAINST THROWN OBJECTS.

9. ALWAYS WEAR EAR PROTECTION AT ALL TIMES.

10. BEWARE OF THROWN OBJECTS. KEEP BYSTANDERS AT LEAST 50 FEET AWAY DURING OPERATION.
