Live Animal Trap

Baiting

Center bait in cage approximately 2” from back.

For small animals such as groundhogs and rabbits, use a fresh slice of apple. For Squirrels and chipmunks, use peanut butter.

For raccoons, use fruit preserves on bread or fish parts (fresh, canned or frozen).

Setting

Lift door and set trigger by putting finger through side of cage and pushing trigger rod forward.

For the lightest trigger release setting, place just the tip of the trigger rod under the door cross rod. For the heaviest trigger release setting, push the end of the trigger rod completely under the door cross rod.

DO NOT ATTEMPT TO HANDLE TRAPPED ANIMALS

Please Note:

If you have difficulty setting your Havahart Live Animal Cage Trap, it may be due to the trigger rod becoming “hung up” on the trap door. To correct this problem, simply pull the long trigger rod forward until the circular portion on the trigger rod clears the door then set the trap in the customary manner.
